Campers create original stories and characters inspired by their own strengths and interests while building creativity, compassion, and courage to *Be Bold!* through theatre games and collaborative play. Family and friends are invited to join us for a celebratory sharing on the final day of camp.

Where to Go

Camp is located at **Cromwell Park, 18030 Meridian Ave. N., Shoreline, WA 98133**. Our "home base" is the Amphitheater. Please park in the Shoreline Courthouse parking lot.

We'll have a registration table on the first day of camp to welcome you. **To facilitate a faster check-in, please fill out Shoreline Parks and Recs Guardian Information Sheet prior to camp.** The online form can be found [HERE](#).

Drop Off & Pick Up

On the first day of camp, "doors" open at 8:50am. On Tuesday-Friday, camp doors open at 9:00am. **Our Dandylyon staff will be wearing Dandylyon Drama shirts for easy identification.** Parking is available at the Shoreline Courthouse Parking lot. We look forward to welcoming you to camp!

Pick up will be at the same location as drop off. Campers must be signed out by a designated adult. Please let your Teaching Artist(s) know if someone other than the camper's guardian will be at pick up. Please be prepared to show a photo ID.

Camp Attendance

Camp is Monday–Friday, 9:00am to 3:00pm. We appreciate your child arriving on time and being promptly picked up at the end of camp. Ideally your child will come to camp every day to get the full experience, however, *please keep your child home if they are sick with a fever, diarrhea, vomiting, or other symptoms of the flu or COVID-19.*

What You'll Be Doing

Over our 5 days of camp, we'll be having so much fun! We'll explore stories surrounding our theme, develop characters, make crafts, and create our own original showcase.

A typical camp day will include the following:

- Drama warm ups, games & songs
- Crafts
- Snack Breaks and Lunch
- Free Play
- Acting time

What to Bring to Camp

We will have camp rain or shine. Please dress your child for the weather of the day – think layers!

Camp Materials

Please send your camper to camp with a large backpack that can hold everything below:

Clothing

- ✓ Wear comfortable, appropriate active clothes
- ✓ Wear sturdy shoes (no flip flops)
- ✓ For rain: send rain boots, water-resistant jacket, extra layers of clothing
- ✓ For extreme heat: send campers IN quick dry clothing for water play (campers will not be able to change clothing at camp)
- ✓ A Dandylyon Drama t-shirt is handed out on the first day of camp. For safety, **we ask campers to wear their camp shirts every day.**

Food

- ✓ Hearty snacks that are NUT FREE
- ✓ Large FULL water bottle

Personal items

- ✓ Small chair/camping chair or blanket/towel to sit on
- ✓ Apply sunscreen before arriving at camp
- ✓ Please **do not** send your child with cash. (We will provide popsicles on hot days, students will NOT be allowed to purchase items if an ice cream truck comes.)

We do not keep a Lost & Found box. Please be sure to collect all of your camper's belongings after Friday's showcase. Any unclaimed items will be donated or recycled, unless we hear from you within 24 hours after the last day of camp.

Showcase Performance

Final sharing and showcase will take place on Friday at 2:30pm.

Parking is available in the Shoreline Courthouse parking lot and on the street. Plan for the event to last approximately 30 minutes. For your own comfort, feel free to bring a blanket or camp chair to sit on.

Accommodations

Everyone has certain accessibility requirements to succeed. Please contact us before the first day of camp so that we can best accommodate you or your student's needs. We are not able to provide 1:1 student to teacher care.

Policies and Procedures

Camp Refunds

Please contact the City of Shoreline's Recreation Department directly for questions about refunds. Per their refund policy, no refunds will be given if requested less than 14 calendar days of the first day of camp.

Dandylyon Drama reserves the right to cancel any camp, at any time, due to low enrollment.

Air Quality

Per City of Shoreline's Recreation Department, any outdoor based camps will be canceled if the air quality is in the red or above 150. Dandylyon Drama will be following their guidelines.

Late Pick-Up Policy

If a child remains in attendance after camp has finished, the following steps will be taken:

- Staff members will remain at the camp with the child.
- Staff members will call the camper's adult.
- Parents will be charged \$25, payable to Dandylyon Drama, for any time after 15 minutes post camp ending.

Please let us know if you are running late so we can make arrangements to stay with your child.
